Reported to be aground at 0012 on Copalis Beach, WA on Griffiths-Priday Ocean State Park with 4 Persons on Board. No injuries; vessel not taking on water. No fuel spilled.

Vessel is reported to have 2000 gallons of diesel and 200 gallons of lube and hydraulic oils.


Vessel is carrying 40,000 lbs of crab



Copalis Beach, WA


Approx. 300 yards south of Olympic Coast National Marine Sanctuary


