Navy ship runs aground off Reef Runway

The USS Port Royal, a Pearl Harbor-based guided missile cruiser, ran aground about 9 p.m. Thursday night approximately a half-mile south of the airport's Reef Runway, the Navy reported this morning.

No one was injured in the incident. The extent of damage to the ship and the cause of the grounding, which occurred about a mile and a half from the entrance to Pearl Harbor, are under investigation, the Navy said.

The Port Royal, which was commissioned in July 1994, has a crew of about 360.
