MAR-GUN ONBOARD ACTIVITIES:

OVERVIEW: Bulk Oil Removal from # 3 Starboard Wing Tank	
Time	Activity:
0900	Fill and prepare for Helo Ops
1152	First Barrels off to Heli-Pad
1600	24 Drums off
1800	Total of 28 full drums lifted off. Presently (2) open top drums onboard: (1) Full, (1) 1/4 full. Also (3) bung liquid drums (1) Full, (1) 2/3 full, (1) 1/3 Full

HELI-PAD ACTIVITIES:

OVERVIEW: Visquine cover on Bidar, containment secure.

0900	Prepare for helo ops
1200	Helo Ops in full swing.
1900	Secure Heli-Pad, 6 empty drums staged in containment area.






HELICOPTER ACTIVITIES:

OVERVIEW: Barrel Removal From MAR GUN.

1145	Airborne and removing Barrels
1945	Helo Secure.
